


Buddha Maitreva is the manifestation of all the Buddhas' realization of loving kindness. This Festival is a unique opportunity to concentrate on understanding and practising

#### MANJUSHRI KADAMPA MEDITATION CENTRE

Manjushri KMC is the Mother Centre of the NKT. It is Venerable Geshe-la's spiritual home where he lived for many years and began his work making modern Kadampa Buddhism flourish in this world.

Manjushri KMC is home to the first Kadampa Temple for World Peace, and International Spring and Summer Festivals are held here each year.

#### INTERNATIONAL KADAMPA RETREAT CENTER, **GRAND CANYON**

International Kadampa Retreat Center, Grand Canyon is the location of the fifth Kadampa Temple dedicated to World Peace.

The Temple is situated within the beautiful region of Northern Arizona at 7,000 feet above sea level, with stunning mountain views. IKRC Grand Canyon was designed by Venerable Geshe-la and opened in 2019 by Gen-la Dekyong. It is the official international retreat centre for North America.



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# Maniushri KMC









Modern Kadampa Buddhism originated in the UK and has since expanded globally, offering a practical and accessible spiritual path that seamlessly integrates with contemporary life. This tradition is now known as the New Kadampa Tradition. At the heart of this worldwide community is Manjushri Kadampa

Meditation Centre in the Lake District, the Mother Centre of the tradition. Across the UK, over 50 centres offer dynamic programmes of meditation, study and discussion, led by dedicated Teachers. These centres welcome all who seek to cultivate greater peace, wisdom and compassion in their lives.



# **MEXICO**

From north to south, Mexican Kadampas may be culturally different, but they are united by the same heart, the love for Kadam Dharma. Sharing the intention to benefit others, Kadampa practitioners in Mexico help Dharma flourish





Since the first Kadampa centres were established in the United States over 30 years ago, Kadam Dharma has continued to flourish, with new centres arising on a regular basis in towns and cities across the country to meet the growing needs of modern people.

The US is also home to two Kadampa Temples for World Peace in New York and Arizona. These centres and Temples continue to serve as places of inspiration and refuge for everyone, inspiring people in their spiritual life and helping provide precious advice and helpful encouragement.





Dharma has been growing quickly in South America, with many centres having opened during the past few years. The teachings have reached people in Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Nicaragua, Peru and Uruguay, through the kindness of more than twenty Resident Teachers and dedicated practitioners who follow Venerable Geshe-la's example of how to live a spiritual life in modern times. South America is also home to the biggest Kadampa Temple in the world, located in Cabreuva (Brazil), a blessed place of refuge and pilgrimage for Kadampas and all living beings.
